## OSHP MISSION REVIEW TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1) There is no legislative change needed to ORC 5503.02. The Ohio General Assembly intended to impose a limit upon the arrest power of the highway patrol off state property.
- 2) The current policy of OSHP for emergency assistance needs to follow the current ORC 5503.02 (D) (2).

- 4) Capitol Operations and Security of all state owned or leased property(s). Overlap with ORC 5503.09 Special police officers. \$4,699,858.20
- 5) Allow the Ohio Turnpike Commission to competitively bid the contract for enforcement ORC 5503.32.
- 6) LEADS. Overlap with OHLEG and other state data servers. \$4,252,474.04
- 7) Contract dispatching services. Overlap with local agencies that have this service available in each county. No monetary value was given by OSHP to show operation, maintenance, and personnel
- 8) Computer Crimes Unit. Overlap with BCI&I. \$401,671.23
- 9) Special Response Team Unit. Overlap with local law enforcement agencies. \$1,016,807.95
- 10) Caravan aircraft . Overlap with Ohio Homeland Security. No monetary value was given by OSHP to show operations, maintenance, and personnel.
- 11) Investigative Operations. Overlap with BCI&I. \$8,020,988.53.
- 12) Crime Lab. Overlap with BCI&I. \$1,338,567.14
- 13) Polygraph. Overlap with BCI&I. \$441,745.34
- 14) Homeland Security. Other agencies are funded by Homeland Security grant funds. \$228,230.97
- 15) Criminal Intelligence Unit. Overlap with BCI&I. \$512,398.11
